Masculinity & Femininity

- John Piper:
 - Masculinity = “a sense of benevolent responsibility to lead, provide for, and protect women in ways appropriate to a man’s differing relationships.”
 - Femininity = “a freeing disposition to affirm, receive, and nurture strength and leadership from worthy men in ways appropriate to a woman’s differing relationships.”
- Capital Hill Baptist Church / 9 Marks
 - Masculinity = “Biblical masculinity is displayed in a sense of benevolent responsibility to work God’s creation, provide for and protect others, and express loving, sacrificial leadership in particular contexts prescribed by God’s Word.”
 - Femininity = “Biblical femininity is displayed in a gracious disposition to cultivate life; to help others flourish; and to affirm, receive, and nurture strength and leadership from worthy men in particular contexts prescribed by God’s Word.”
