

## **A Godly Woman is Trustworthy – Proverbs 31:11**

*“The heart of her husband trusts in her, and he will have no lack of gain.”*

- 1) Proverbs 3:5-6 tells us to “Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding.” Can your husband have complete confidence in you because he knows you are relying on God’s direction accomplish your tasks? Or if you’re not married, do your parents or friends see that you find your wisdom not within yourself, but from God?

Share a time where you chose to rely on your own understanding at home and did not trust in the LORD. What happened?

- 2) Discuss the link between trusting God and being truly trustworthy. Can someone still be trustworthy and be an unbeliever?
- 3) Are you seeking godly counsel as you manage your home? Do you utilize those God placed in your life, like your pastors or elders, when making decisions?

Describe one or two godly counselors in your life who you would always turn to before making a decision. What characteristics makes them so trustworthy?

- 4) In Ephesians 2:10, we are told that we are “his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.” What good works does God have for you on a regular basis that you find difficult to remain trustworthy?
