# **"Walking With God":** A Personal Vision for God's Word in 2017 Sermon Notes

### □ Walking with God means walking in the Word of God

-Genesis 5:22, 24; 6:9 → Isaiah 30:8-12, 19-21; 1 Samuel 3:21

- If you want to walk as <u>Christ</u> walked, walk in the <u>Word</u> (1 John 2:6; 1 Peter 2:21 → John 5:37-47; Luke 24:25-27, 32, 44; Matthew 28:19-20)
- If you want to walk in the <u>Spirit</u>, walk in the <u>Word</u> (Galatians 5:16; Romans 8:4; Ezekiel 36:27 → Galatians 3:1-5)
- If you want to walk by <u>faith</u>, walk in the <u>Word</u>
  (2 Corinthians 5:7; Romans 4:12; Colossians 2:6 → Romans 10:17)
- 4. If you want to walk in the <u>truth</u>, walk in the <u>Word</u> (3 John 3-4 → Psalm 86:11; John 17:17)
- 5. If you want to walk in <u>love</u>, walk in the <u>Word</u> (Ephesians 5;2 → 1 Timothy 1:5; 1 Corinthians 13:4-8a)
- If you want to walk <u>humbly</u>, walk in the <u>Word</u> (Micah 6:8; Daniel 4:37 → Isaiah 66:2)
- If you want to walk in <u>newness</u> of <u>life</u>, walk in the <u>Word</u> (Romans 6:4 → Romans 12:1-2; Matthew 4:4)

## \*Six ingredients for healthy sermon listening...

- Expect God to speak.
  Peter 1:23-25; Acts 17:1-4; 1 Thessalonians 2:13; 1 Peter 4:11; Nehemiah 8:5
- Admit that God knows better than you.
  2 Timothy 4:3; Hebrews 4:12-13; James 1:12; Luke 11:45; Isaiah 66:2
- 3. Check the preacher says what the passage says. 2 Timothy 4:1-2; Acts 17:10-11; 2 Peter 3:15-18
- 4. Hear the sermon in church. Acts 7:38; Deuteronomy 4:10; Nehemiah 8:1-3
- 5. Be there week by week. Hebrews 10:24-25; Acts 2:46; 2 Peter 1:12; 1 John 2:19
- Do what the Bible says. James 1:22; Luke 8:15; 2 Timothy 3:16-4:5; Mark 6:14-29; Ezekiel 33:32

## \*How to listen to bad sermons...

- → How to listen to a dull (but faithful) sermon (Acts 20:7-12) Repentantly. Expectantly. Patiently. Gratefully. Perhaps with a cup of coffee in hand.
- $\rightarrow$  How to listen to a biblically inadequate sermon (Acts 18:24-28) Humbly. Carefully. Judiciously. Willing to offer loving correction.
- → How to listen to a heretical sermon (2 John 10-11; Romans 16:17-20) Don't.
