Titus 2-Gether February 2023, Session 5: "Working at Home"

Titus 2:3-5: "3 Older women likewise are to be reverent in behavior, not slanderers or slaves to much wine.

They are to teach what is good,

4 and so train the young women to love their husbands and children, 5 to be self-controlled, pure, working at home, kind, and submissive to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be reviled.

- c. Organizing
- d. Meal Planning
- e. Cooking
- f. Budgeting/planning purchases
- g. Shopping
- h. Sewing and mending, handicrafts
- i. Repairing broken things
- j. Working a job out of your home
- k. Caring for children
- l. Discipling children
- m. Teaching and training children
- n. Caring for husband and/or family members or roommates
- o. Caring for neighbors/the community
- p. Gardening/Yard maintenance
- q. Creating a place of peace, beauty and rest for others
